




MANAVGAT Waterfall







Formerly known as Byzantium and later Constantinople, Istanbul's rich history is evident in its architecture, food, and daily life.

Galata Tower: For panoramic views of Istanbul, head to Galata Tower. Dating back to medieval times, it offers breathtaking vistas of the city and the Bosphorus. Unfortunately, his girlfriend couldn't find him. Unable to descend or call out, Nazım wrote on paper: "I am a walnut tree in Gülhane Park; neither are you aware of this, nor the police."

Istiklal Avenue: Istiklal Avenue's cobblestone streets echo with the tales of poets and artists who found inspiration in its vibrant ambiance. This bustling pedestrian street is filled with shops, cafes, and a lively atmosphere, especially in the evenings.

The Maiden's Tower (Turkish: Kız Kulesi), also known as Leander's Tower (Tower of Leandros) since the Byzantine period, is a tower on a small islet at the southern entrance of the Bosphorus strait, 200 m (220 yd) from the coast of Üsküdar in Istanbul, Turkey. The most romantic legend tells of a princess who, to protect her beloved from a snakebite, fed him a fateful grape. Today, the tower stands as a symbol of enduring love.

Bosphorus Cruise: Sail the Bosphorus, where folklore claims sea nymphs once enchanted sailors with their mesmerizing songs. Enjoy the cruise along the city's skyline and historic landmarks from the water.


